



## Alveley reading challenge!





What characters you could include on your cover

The setting of the story (What setting will be in the background? A school, house, forest etc.)

The title (What writing will you use?)

2. Imagine a character from your favourite book. What does he/she look like? Use your imagination to draw your character and create a poster. You may want to do a series of characters like Harry, Ron and Hermione, the winning ticket children from Charlie and the Chocolate Factory or you could even try and draw a beast or monster from Goosebumps!
