We've missed you joining in with tales of soldiers and Daniel in the Lion's den.

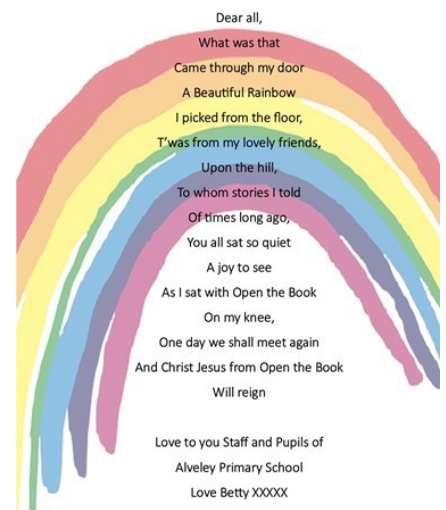
We've missed your laughs and claps, and faces smiling as you welcome Open the Book.
