Things you might need.

A cardboard box – this might be a cereal or shoe box, it can be as big or as small as you would like. You may want to use something else like a wooden vegetable box or biscuit tin or even create a rainforest on a plate!

Plasticine may be helpful to stand up trees or even model your own rainforest animals. You may have toy animals you want to include.

Toilet rolls may make excellent trees or find some twigs in the garden. Pipe cleaners could be some super winding vines perhaps.
