This might be birthdays, new members to the family or any other exciting news from your child or family this month.

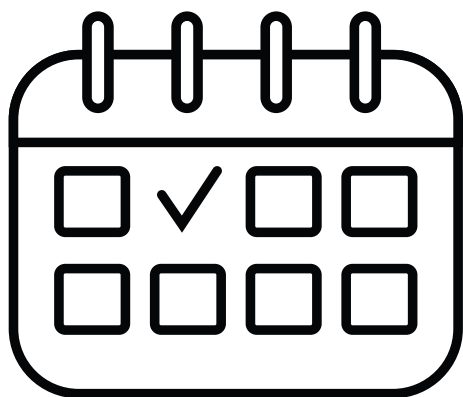
### Acts of Kindness
