We will start our topic with looking at eggs including watching real eggs in an incubator! We will then move onto dinosaurs after finding "secret eggs" hidden in school. The children will become palaeontologist's as they explore different dinosaurs, their habitats, food, sizes and pattern! We are also watching some frogspawn develop and will be planting some seeds to add to our forest school area through the summer term.
