#### Cedar

We have had a busy month in Cedar! We have taken lots of our learning outdoors. We spent a week outside exploring capacity in Maths. We have also been busy planting in our Science lessons. We investigated and predicted what we thought had happened by looking at what our visitor had left behind. In maths the class have been creative in showing how we can visually learn about equivalent fractions.
