Forest school will be on a Friday afternoon.


Please ensure your child comes to school wearing trousers suitable for forest school and school uniform on top. Please bring waterproofs and wellingtons to change into, in a bag.

This term we will be working on ball control.


Please bring PE kit on Monday and come to school in your PE kit on Tuesday.

#### What we are covering in each subject

Literacy- There will be plenty of different writing opportunities, such as fire poems, London brochure and a time travel story.

Science- We will be focussing on weather and seasonal change, taking time to explore the environment around us and develop our knowledge and understanding.

Music- This term will be looking at body percussion and rhythm.

Art- We will be exploring abstract art. We will take time to find out about artists and to create our own pieces.

PSHE- We will take time to explore feelings, being a good friend and focus on our wellbeing.

**RE-** We will be finding out about celebrations.

**Computing -** We are exploring resources online, using purple mash.

Maths- We will be focussing on our understanding of number, place value and applying this to addition and subtraction.
