We will be outdoors when possible, so ensure you bring trainers and warm jumper.


ART - In Art we will learn about how and why art was created thousands of years ago, making homemade paints from natural materials, and replicating painting techniques from the past.

In Science we will be learning about rocks and fossils; discovering how fossils are formed and classifying dinosaurs.

We will take opportunities to link our learning in Science with Forest School sessions. Forest school will be on a Thursday afternoon. Please ensure your child brings a bag with trousers suitable for forest school, warm layers, waterproofs and wellingtons to change into.
