English: This term we will be writing stories and nonfiction based on the wider world around us, notably mountains and country sides.

MFL: In French we will be learning about French speaking countries across the globe and their directions.



<u>Maths - Maths:</u> This term our learning will focus on the use of decimal numbers in contexts of measuring and counting. The introduction into decimals that I always use with the children is to count in money; £1.23. Then the application of converting this to fractions and percentages too. All of these will then be taught and applied in practical contexts and settings.

PE: On Tuesday and Thursday. This term we will be working our flexibility and core strength, through circuits as well as learning skills for invasion ball games. Please ensure PE kit is in school on these days. Computing & Music: Oak class will design, record and evaluate spreadsheets and multimedia presentations... In music we will study film soundtracks and design their own ideas for films.

RE: This term Oak class will learn the roles of religions within modern society. Local places of worship for differing religions and similarities between their beliefs into how we treat society around us.

<u>PSHE</u>: Focus will be an ourselves and our relationship to money as well as it's impact on our lives.

In Science we will be learning how humans and animals have evolved and how we adapt to suit different environments. We will also be learning the differences between adaption and evolution
