
Class Topic Days

At Alveley we are continuing to use Tapestry across the school. Tapestry is an on-line system which allows us to share updates, photographs, and videos of your child and what they have been learning about with in their class. It can be accessed via the internet or downloaded as an app from itunes, android or google play. Tapestry has the facility to email parents whenever a new observation is added to their child's profile to keep you up to date with what your child has been learning about in school. Parents have access 24/7 to their child's profile and can comment on the observations added by school staff. You can add also add your own updates to share news and achievements from home. If you are having any issue with accessing Tapestry or cannot remember your password, then please mention this to your child's class teacher and we will get you up and running again.

Christmas Fayre we raised £231.64 Nativity Refreshments £61.69 Raffle £402.60



Over the next term there are going to be virtual workshops that have been made available for all parents for children of any age. These workshops will be free and voluntary for all and are designed to help and support children, parents and professionals through different aspects of children's emotional health.

They are offered through the Shropshire Beam service which is an emotional health and wellbeing service for young people. The sessions will be focused on: Supporting Children & Young People with Anxiety, Wellbeing Planning and Sleep Support.

Workshops

Supporting Children & Young People with Anxiety - Aims & objectives are to pass over psycho - education within the topic followed by practical suggestions of methods & techniques to help support the youth experience issues with anxiety.

Wellbeing Planning – a workshop which explains & provides a tool for Children & Young people to support their general Emotional Health & Wellbeing, it recognises triggers and promotes self-awareness, his can also be used as a relapse tool to support resilience.

Sleep Support - aims to pass over psycho - education within the topic followed by practical suggestions & advise of methods & techniques to help support the children & young people having difficulties with getting to sleep and staying asleep.
