## What we are covering in each subject

**Music-** This term we're linking music to different stories all based around different animals and living things.

**Art-** We will be making different statues, including a large scale spider statue!

**PSHE-** We are looking at what it means to be a TEAM member and remembering that Together Everyone Achieves More and we will also be thinking a little a bit about money in the world around us.

**RE-** We will be finding out about how nature is linked into religions.

**Computing -** We are going to be creating our own mazes for a friend to complete.

**Maths-** We will be focussing on consolidating our multiplication skills as well as beginning to learn about time.
