Our topic for Summer term is **'Under the Sea'**

Our Topic will link with many areas of the curriculum and will be part of our daily literacy lessons. The children have already shown real excitement and interest in this topic!

Literacy: Our topic will inspire a variety of types of writing, including poetry, stories and information texts.

Maths: During this term we will continue to develop recall of timetables. We will also learn about place value, decimals, including money, time and shape.

<u>Geography:</u> We will explore the uses of Seas and Oceans and the impact of pollution in habitats.

French: Our learning in French this term will link to playground games. We will develop our vocabulary and have a go at some tradition French games.

Science: In Science we will be working on magnetics and forces in the first half of the term and then looking at science linked to our under the sea theme. We will plan an investigation and challenge ourselves in our scientific thinking.

PE: This term we will be working on under the sea themed Dance and will have Cricket coaching from a Shropshire coach. PE days will be Monday and Friday. This term pupils will use the wider school grounds as well as Forest School, generally they will not require to change into kit for these outdoor activities. On occasion when they do a text will be sent in advance.

Computing: In computing we will develop our knowledge of effective searching and our touch typing skills. We will also create logos.
