Writing opportunities: This term will learn write biographies of Queen Victoria, 19th century stories and reflective diaries about life as a child labourer.

History and Geography skills: Children will locate Commonwealth countries on a world map, compare their lives with those of children in Victorian ties and examine how the rise of factories altered society, travel and new leisure time on Saturdays.





Wider topic opportunities:

Religion Children will learn to research and describe how Quakers and their businesses lives were affected by their beliefs.

Music We will research the music halls and recreate the songs chosen at the height of the Victorian era.

Art Children will examine leading artists of the era and recreate their scenic pictures.

Design Technology Plan, create and evaluate suspension bridge model

French Children will learn to describe the countries in the Commonwealth, their flags and continents they are located.

Computing To create a multimedia presentation explaining about life in Victorian England.

<u>Maths</u> Children will learn to use written strategies to solve  $4 \times 2$ -digit multiplication and their division opposites. Converting fraction, decimal and percentage equivalents. Apply these to multistep measure challenges involving time duration, length, weight and capacity.

<u>Science</u> To learn that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them
