This will be part of our daily routine whereby the children will be asked to read independently and part of a class or small group.





## What we are covering in each subject

Literacy- We will be basing some of our learning on looking at the text 'Where the Rainforest Meets the sea' by Jeanie Baker and looking at how the text is constructed and the use of ambitious language choices. We will write in a range of different genres, inspired by our Rainforest topic.

Maths-We will be furthering our understanding of addition and subtraction, as well as developing our knowledge and understanding of multiplication and related number facts.

<u>Science</u> Our Science unit is Living Things and their Habitats, we will develop our knowledge and understanding through research and experiments.

Music- This term we will be developing and composing music to represent what we have found out about the rainforest.

Art—We will be exploring and creating patterns which represent patterns from rainforest animals.

PSHE—We are looking at friendships and relationships and developing understanding/empathy around how bonds develop and are formed.

RE- We will be developing knowledge and understanding about Christianity, thinking about God and creation.
Camputing - We are exploring Purple Mash to develop our knowledge and understanding about keeping safe, whilst using computers/devices.
