All children are always welcome to borrow a book from the book corner. We will begin our topic by looking at 'ourselves', what do we look like, what is the same as our friends, what is different? We will explore our senses by going on a senses walk and looking and listening. We will explore our sense of taste by tasting healthy fruits and vegetables.
