PE will be on a Thursday afternoon, P.E. kit is required for all <u>Reception</u> children-blue shorts, white T-shirt, ,black pumps


Purple Mash is our online learning facility where children can explore different areas of learning and each child has personal login details which can be used at home and school. Please ask if you have forgotten your log in.

Underground

Reading books and diary Reception have reading books to
support sounds taught in
phonics. Please read together at
least twice a week and record
this reading in reading diaries
when you read together at home.
Children will be given sets of
sounds to practice at home as
we learn them in school.

to borrow a book from the book
corner.

We will begin our topic by looking at which animals live underground, worms, moles, ants, rabbits. We will also explore what grows underground, vegetables. As part of our Understanding the World strand of learning we will look at Chinese New Year and how people celebrate it. The children will have the opportunity to follow maps on a secret trail to find treasure left by Percy the Park Keeper too!
