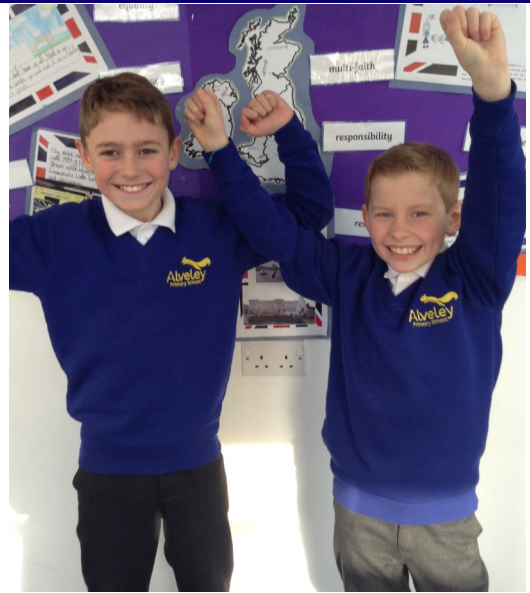


We are really pleased to welcome our new Nursery friends who are settling well into our EYFS class.
