Reading

What we are covering in each subject

Literacy- We are learning to write the start of a story, non-chronological reports and writing a comic strip.

Maths- We will be learning about place value and shape.

History- We will be learning about how we are making history.

Science- We will be looking at mini-beasts.

Music- We are learning pitch, with the theme of superheroes.

Art- We will be exploring 3D sculptures.

PSHE- We are looking at health and wellbeing.

RE- We will be exploring the topic 'why Christmas is important to Christians'.

Computing - We are looking at effective searching.
