Maths-We will be continuing to look at addition and subtraction. Then we will be looking at mastering our multiplications and divisions.

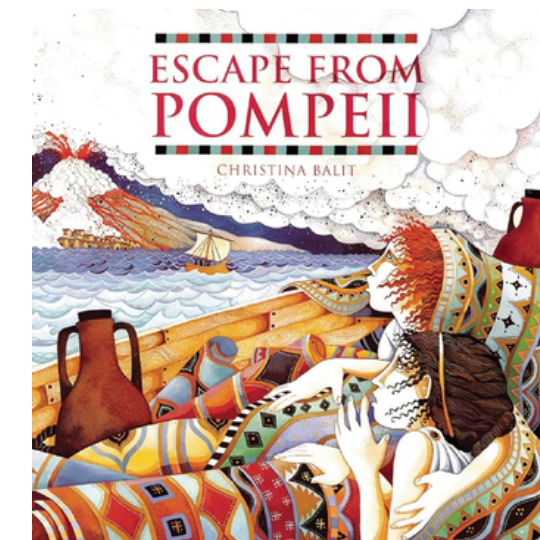
Geography- We will be looking at what it is like to live near a volcano and whether we would like to or not.
