What we are covering in each subject

Literacy- We are learning to write a recount, a letter, a set of instructions and poems.

Maths- We will be learning about place value as well as addition, subtraction; leading onto multiplication and fractions.

Geography- We will be learning about where we live and our local area.

Science- We will be looking at living things and their habitats as well as learning about seasonal changes.

Music- We are learning how to sing, play instruments and use letter notation to create a melody.

Art- We will be exploring painting and mix media, learning about primary and secondary colours.
