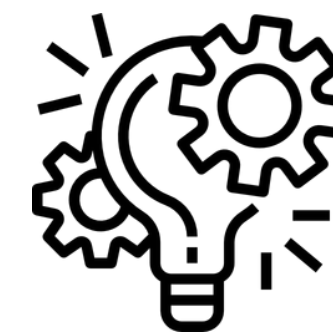




Elm class Newsletter

This term we will be working with Cricket Shropshire, Mr Lockley and Mr Bennet doing cricket and athletics.

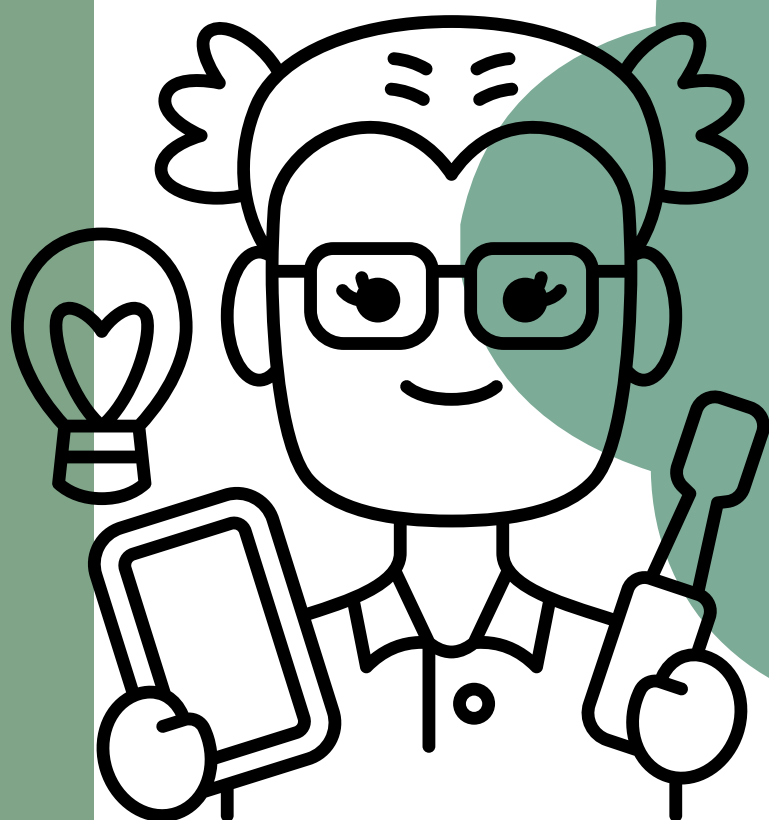
Please come to school in your PE kits.

What we are covering in each subject
