This half term our class are going to be...

Writers (Literacy): This half term we will be reading our class book 'The Diver's Daughter'. We will be focusing on narratives, instructions and discussions.

Mathematicians (Maths): This half term we will be looking at fractions, decimals and percentages. In the second half of the half term we will be looking at area, perimeter and volume.

Historians (History): We will be looking at what life is like in the Tudor times.

Scientists (Science): We will focus on animals including humans. Also, we will describe the changes as humans develop from birth to old age.
