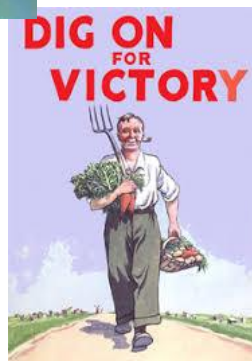
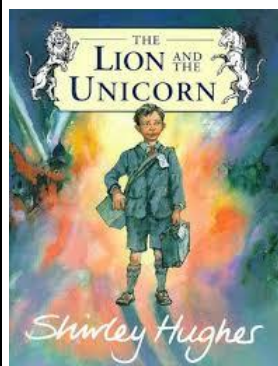
As always, if you have any queries, please do not hesitate to speak to me at the gate or classroom door.

This half term our class are going to be...
